

# CAMP RULES

## ARKANSAS DISTRICT U.P.C.I

*In order to attend camp and for your personal welfare and safety, these rules must be strictly adhered to. Rules for acceptance and participation are the same for everyone without regard to race, color, or national origin. These rules apply to **ALL** Youth Camps and for those of Youth camp age attending camp meeting.*

1. Dorms will be closed from breakfast until shower time with the exception of changing clothes at recreation time or at the discretion of the Camp Director, (Department Head in charge).
2. Lights will be out each night as determined by Camp Director
3. Each student is to be responsible for his or her own luggage and must pass dorm inspection daily.
4. Students are not allowed to leave the campground at any time (even with parents) without permission from the Camp Director or Registrar.
5. Students must sit in reserved sections of the tabernacle and are expected to conduct themselves in a respective and Godly manner.
6. Students are required to attend all classes and services as outlines on the camp schedule.
7. All students must stay in the tabernacle through each service until dismissed.
8. Students must respect the request of the staff and instructors concerning campus behavior.
9. Students are asked to participate in some type of recreation activity. They will not be allowed in the dorms unless arrangements are made with the Camp Director.
10. All campers leaving the campgrounds before check-out time Friday must check out at the registration office.
11. Campers enrolling in Kids Camp are ages 8-11. Those enrolled in Junior Camp are to be 12-14, Senior Camp ages are 15-19.
12. Children's Church will be conducted until lunch during camps for the benefit of the workers children.
13. Everyone attending any of the camps must be registered as a student, worker, worker's child, or as a visitor. Anyone under 18 not enrolled must have a Camp Director or Coordinator approved, adult supervisor present.
14. No one enrolled or registered in camp shall violate the rules of the manual of the United Pentecostal Church Int. (i.e. Hair, dress, cosmetics, conduct, etc..).
15. All Youth Camps officially end on Friday afternoon. No one will be allowed to stay in the dorms Friday night.
16. No person except registered students, workers, or worker's children of the age of the camp they attend shall be allowed to participate in the recreational sports of the camp.
17. All children of the camp workers who are in the age bracket of the camp they are attending with their parents must register as a camper and participate in the scheduled activities.
18. All adults staying in the cabins with campers must register and be approved as a worker.
19. All students staying in cabins must abide by the same schedule and rules as students in the dorms.
20. No student is to enter a cabin without camp approved adult supervision.
21. Violation to any rule/rules, may constitute dismissal or result in other disciplinary action.

These are in the interest of making your camp safe and as pleasant as possible for everyone.
